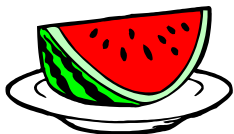

- 1) High Meadow can provide Drink Tickets, to be distributed in advance to your guests, redeemed at the bar, and billed to you at \$3.00* per ticket, OR**
- 2) Guests may simply purchase beer or wine at the bar, on a cash basis at \$3.50 per drink.**

Western-Style Horseback Riding will be available (weather permitting) for adults on an individual basis at \$30.00 per trail ride.

Steps to having a great employee picnic at High Meadow

- * In order to make a reservation on one of our shared-site days we will ask you to guarantee a minimum number of adult guests (ages 12 and over) – this number may vary, so please call us if you are unsure how many guests you can guarantee. Your group will be sharing High Meadow with other groups on the day of your event. A seating area will be set-aside for your group and a large sign provided.
- * Please have one or two coordinators for your event who will also serve as contacts for High Meadow with regard to attendance numbers and payments.
- * Once you have decided to hold your event at High Meadow and an available date has been mutually agreed upon – you will receive an outing contract.
- * The outing contract describes the terms of your agreement with High Meadow – menus and entertainment features, prices and minimum guaranteed attendance - and must be signed and returned within 15 days – along with your non-refundable reservation deposit of \$1,500. This deposit will be applied to your final balance.
- * Once you have returned your contract along with your deposit, High Meadow will supply you with brochures and flyers to help you promote your event. Your staff can also be encouraged to visit our website at www.highmeadowresort.com for more information about the resort. You will also be provided with admission bracelets for adults (ages 12 and over) and for children (ages 3 to 11) that you will distribute to your guests accordingly. (The High Meadow staff will collect the stub of each bracelet before allowing your guests to enter the resort on the day of your event.)
- * Please keep an alphabetical list of your attending guests and provide it to the High Meadow staff on the morning of your picnic – the list will be used in the event that some of your guests misplace their bracelets and show up at the event without them.
- * Please be sure to tell your guests to bring their bathing suits and towels. All other sporting equipment will be supplied by High Meadow. Please tell them also that pets are not allowed on the premises due to health regulations.
- * Payment for the reservation deposit can be made by COMPANY CHECK or CREDIT CARD (MasterCard or VISA). The balance due must be paid by COMPANY CHECK.
- * And when you arrive at High Meadow - you can relax and enjoy your day !!
